**RULES:** Current IJF Modified. Choking prohibited for Junior competitors who are under 13 years of age.

Arm Bars prohibited for all Junior and Novice competition.

**SCORING:** Modified Double Elimination for 5 or more

Round Robin for 4 or less

Tournament Director may adjust weight categories, divisions and brackets if necessary.

Tournament Director is the final authority to modify weight classes and divisions.

**AWARDS:** Medals for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup>. Junior and Senior Team Award to be awarded to the clubs with the most points (First = 3 points, Second = 2 points, and Third = 1 point). Outstanding Male and Female Junior competitor and outstanding Male and Female Senior competitor.

**ELIGIBILITY:**

All contestants must be active members in good standing of USA Judo, USJA, or USJF. Bring your card as proof of membership. (Applications for USJA and USA Judo memberships may be made at the tournament. Only competitors with a rank of Sankyu and above will be permitted to compete in the Senior and Masters Divisions. Only competitors with ranks Yonkyu and below will be permitted to compete in the Novice Divisions. All senior and masters competitors who do not hold the rank of Senior Sankyu, or above are required to present the Certificate Regarding Non Black Belt Contestants, signed by their Sensei, at the time of registration. (See Application form.) Junior competitors, who hold the equivalent rank of Senior Sankyu (or above) and who are at least 15 years old, may compete in the Senior divisions. Juniors who compete in senior competition play by senior rules and must also present the Certificate Regarding Non Black Belt Contestants.

**WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND AGREEMENT TO PARTICIPATE**

In consideration of being permitted to participate in any way, including travel to and from, the 11<sup>th</sup> Annual Alamo Judo Classic and related events and activities of the United States Judo, Inc., United States Judo Federation, United States Judo Association, Texas Judo, Inc., the city of San Antonio, Mission Concepcion Sports Park, the State of Texas, their officers, servants, agents or employees, and Alamo Judo Club, I hereby

1. **Acknowledge that I am familiar with the sport of Judo and understand the rules governing the sport of Judo.**
2. Agree that prior to participating, I will inspect the mats, equipment, facilities, competition pools or divisions, and the elimination or scoring system to be used, and if I believe anything is unsafe or beyond my capability, I will immediately advise my coach, supervisor, and/or a tournament official of such condition(s) and refuse to participate.
3. Acknowledge and fully understand that I will be engaging in a contact sport that might result in serious injury, including permanent disability or death, TBI (Traumatic Brain Injury) and severe social and economic loss due to not only my own actions, inactions, or negligence, but also to the actions, inactions, or negligence of others, the rules of the sport of Judo, or conditions of the premises or of any equipment used. Further, I acknowledge that there may be other risks not known to me or not reasonably foreseeable at this time.
4. Knowing the risks involved in the sport of Judo, I assume all such risks and accept personal responsibility for the damages following such injury, permanent disability or death.
5. Release, waive, and discharge and covenant not to sue the United States Judo, Inc., United States Judo Federation, United States Judo Association, Texas Judo, Inc., the Alamo Judo Club, the city of San Antonio, Mission Concepcion Sports Park and the State of Texas together with their affiliated clubs, their respective administrators, directors, officers, agents, coaches, and other employees or volunteers of the organization, event officials, medical personnel, other participants, their parents, guardian(s), supervisors and coaches, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and , if applicable, owners, lessors and lessees of premises used to conduct the event, all of whom are hereinafter referred to as "leasee", from any and all claims, demands, losses, or damages on account of injury, including permanent disability and death and damage to property, caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the leasee or otherwise to the fullest extent permitted by law.
